#### **COVID Guidance Update**

- Individual establishments can now carry out their own risk assessments around the requirement to wear face coverings. Through discussion with the staff team, we have agreed that face coverings will no longer be mandatory within the setting. However, if individuals choose to continue wearing face coverings, they will be supported to do so. This change will be monitored. If we have an outbreak of covid cases within the setting (2 or more linked cases), we will review this decision.
- Hand Hygiene remains a priority for both staff and children.
- Ventilation continues to be a priority and CO2 monitors are used throughout the setting to monitor this.
- Anyone, staff or children, displaying covid symptoms should not attend the setting until they are well.
- Testing is now not a requirement for the general public.
   However, staff have surplus testing kits and will use these if they have symptoms as a precaution for now.

### WHATS GOING ON IN NURSERY THIS MONTH

We will be learning about the growing cycle as we watch and care for our seeds as they grow.

We will be using our magnifying glasses and books to learn about insects as we hunt for bugs in the garden.

As part of our physical programme the children will be participating in races, skipping, egg and spoon races, and hopscotch in the garden and at the basketball court.

We have been getting very creative and crafty for our Jubilee Party. The children have been enjoying learning about the Queen in preparation for our celebrations.

We will be using resources such as plastic tweezers with pom poms to develop fine motor skills, which are essential for developing pencil control.

In maths and numeracy, we will explore positional language, learning to describe directions using a variety of games and toys.

The pre-school children are working hard preparing for our end of term presentation, they have been working hard to come up with different ideas and songs that we are looking forward to performing for you all.

#### **ECO NEWS**

We are continuing with our weekly book sale on Thursdays as part of our Eco Schools programme. The books are donated and then re-sold to the children. Taking part in this enables children to contribute as Responsible citizens by reducing and recycling.

The children themselves organise the sale by arranging the books and taking on the roles of shopkeeper and customers. Using the till encourages the children to develop an awareness of how money is used and to recognise a range of coins. The price of each book is 20p and to allow as many children as possible to take part, the day of the sale varies weekly. While all children can 'buy' a book without money, it is a good idea to give your child a small purse to keep in their bag with a few coins so that they can buy their book independently.

We are also continuing with our litter picking and trip to the woods.
