to be accompanied by an adult while on the float. A list will be put up nearer the time for you to add your name to. If you are interested in being on the working group, please get in touch.




Nursery Sessions 2023 – 2024

Lending Library

- Bring the book back within a week and record date of return on the sheet.
- > Choose another book.
