

Children's Session Times

To help our sessions run smoothly, we kindly ask parents and carers to adhere to allocated start and finish times. Thank you for your support.

Nursery Sessions 2026 – 2027

We will shortly be allocating places for session 2026 – 2027. You will receive a letter asking if you wish your child to continue with the same sessions as this year or if you wish anything different. It would be helpful to allow us to allocate new starts if you could return the form as soon as possible.

All children are entitled to up to 1140 hours of Early Learning and Childcare each year. For term-time establishments such as us, this equates to 30 hours per week. The most popular option is 9am – 3pm, equivalent to a school day. You can also have 3 long days from 8am – 6pm or 4 x 7.5-hour days starting at 8, 8.30 or 9am and finishing at 3.30, 4 or 4.30pm. If you require more flexible sessions, please contact us to discuss your requirements. Additional hours can also be purchased at an hourly rate of £5.50. (subject to change)

We are aware that some families have issues around childcare over school holidays. We would like to make you aware that your early learning and childcare funding can be split between two different childcare providers. This would allow you to share a place with Kilbarchan Community Nursery and a registered childminder or all year-round children's centre. If you would like more information on this option, please contact the nursery.

Children due to start nursery in 2026 - 2027

Children who will reach their 2nd birthday by 28th February 2026 will be eligible to start nursery during the next academic year. Applications should be submitted to the nursery by the end of January.

Sensory and creative play


Stories about feelings and emotions

Sponsored Event – March


We would like to raise money to subsidise our summer trip and for end of term celebrations. More details to follow.
